Thank you for reaching out regarding Project #P5938.92, which is designed to evaluate and recommend improvements to help control flooding within the McDuffie Twin Parks neighborhood. The consultant prepared a conceptual idea that would renovate the park and allow it to be used as a park and retention pond. That was conceptual and nothing has move forward.

Our intent was to hold a series of public meetings in April and May, collect information and move forward with a recommendation that help to solve the flooding problem and one that could be accepted by the neighborhood.
